Our verse today is Ex. 3:7

Ex. 3:7 YHWH said, "I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering.

Ever felt like YHWH doesn't notice what you may be going through? Ever felt like YHWH doesn't hear your prayers? Ever felt like you're all alone in this big crazy world?

The Israelites felt the same way. This verse is where we see YHWH talking to Moses at the burning bush. YHWH was working in their salvation. He had already planned out their deliverance and was now putting it into action. Yet, did the Israelites see what He was doing? No. Did they have any idea what His plans were. Not a clue.
