May 24 - Luke 6:27,28 - His Disciples pt. 2

Hello and thanks for joining in on today's daily devotion. Today is Tuesday, May 24th. The 3rd day of the Hebraic week.

Our verses today is Luke 6:27,28.

Luke 6:27 "But I tell you who hear me: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, 28 bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.

Now, if you remember correctly, yesterday we read from John 13:35 that told us all men will know that we are His disciples, if we love one another. Then we closed yesterday out with the question of "What is Love"? Now, before we dig into that answer, I want us to ponder these other words that Yeshua gave us about loving others.
