### *July 7 - 1 Peter 1:13 - Prepared*

Hello and thanks for joining in on to today's daily devotion. Today is Thursday, July 7th. The 5th day of the Hebraic week.

Our verse today is 1 Peter 1:13.

1 Peter 1:13 Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed.

I've said it before and I'll say it again, the mind is the battlefield. It really is. So how well do we prepare our minds? Everything we do or say starts in the mind. So what do we focus on?
