Our verses today is James 5:17,18.

James 5:17 Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. 18 Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops.

Elijah was a man just like us. I don't know about you but many times when I read the scriptures I tend to imagine things in my head about that which I am reading. As a result, I often forget that the very stories that I'm reading are real life events. Real life events with real life people.

People. People who were definitely sold out to YHWH, no doubt. Yet, they were still people. So what should this tell us?
