July 16 - 1 Peter 2:22,23 - The Example

Hello and thanks for joining in on to today's daily devotion. Today is Saturday, July 16th. The 7th day of the Hebraic week. And everybody says "HalleluYah."

Our verses today are 1 Peter 2:22,23.

1Pet. 2:22 He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth." 23 When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly.

The previous verses talked how Yeshua gave us the example of suffering for doing good. And here we see what he did during the suffering. I want to read our verse one more time. But as I do, I ask that you put yourself in His shoes and remember that this is the example we are to be following.

Ready? Here we go.
