Follow Through - Isaiah 1:19,20

Isaiah 1:19 If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best from the land; 20 but if you resist and rebel, you will be devoured by the sword." For the mouth of YHWH has spoken.

"If you are willing and obedient." These are the words of YHWH Himself. Did He say to just believe? No. He didn't. He said "If you are willing and obedient."

Remember what Yeshua said to His disciples in the garden?

Matt. 26:41 "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak."
