Discipline - Deuteronomy 8:5

Deut. 8:5 Know then in your heart that as a man disciplines his son, so YHWH your God disciplines you.

If ever we receive discipline from YHWH, then we know we deserve it. That also means we have no right to be angry or bitter because of that discipline. Remember, He disciplines us for our good.
