Jer. 32:25 And though the city will be handed over to the Babylonians, you, O Sovereign YHWH, say to me, 'Buy the field with silver and have the transaction witnessed.'" 26 Then the word of YHWH came to Jeremiah: 27 "I am YHWH, the God of all mankind. Is anything too hard for me?"
