Matthew 10:32,33 - Acknowledging Him

Matthew 10:32,33 “Whoever acknowledges me before men, I will also acknowledge him before my Father in heaven. 33 But whoever disowns me before men, I will disown him before my Father in heaven.

Of course, the immediate response for most is “Of course not!” Yet, the previous verses are discussing persecution of believers. You see, it's easy to acknowledge Him when it's fashionable to do so.
